## **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS OF THE JOB:**

- Responsible for preparing various projects for the fabricators.
- Provide back-up assistance to the fabricators in rolling and bending.
- Responsible for grinding, punching, shearing and sawing of metal parts.
- Provide assistance to the shear, burn and saw operators as directed.
- Responsible for the transportation of materials around shop floor.
- Other duties as assigned.

## REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITY:

- Familiar with using measurement tools such as a tape measure, square and protractor.
- Ability to use hand tools.
- Able to follow directions, ask questions, and learn from layout supervisors.
- Training or experience operating a forklift, jib crane, and overhead crane.
- Must adhere to company safety standards at all times.
- Work and communicate well with others.

#### PHYSICAL DEMANDS:
